Wolves were officially wiped out in France at the beginning of the 20th century. However, there has always been a population in Italy. Gradually over the years, they have migrated back into the French Alps.

In their search for new territories, the Southern Alps, with its wild and unspoilt mountains rich in chamois, mouflon, wild boar, deer and other prey, has proved to be a perfect habitat.

Your tracker and high mountain guide has been following the colonisation of the wolves in the area for 20 years. With a wealth of local knowledge and years of tracking and mountaineering experience, he will ensure your safety in the wilderness and help you to understand the lives of these rare animals.

The area is very wild and still relatively untouched, so you will need to be prepared for walking 'off piste', through woods and undergrowth, and on steep ground. A good level of fitness is required.
